| 1 | Disconnect the DucoBox from the power supply. If the system is valve-controlled, the valves can remain connected.  |                           |

| 2 | Connect the Communication Print (WIFI); it may also be part of the DUCO Installation Kit. Make sure the latest/needed software version is in the Communication Print (WIFI) $\rightarrow$ if not, insert an SD card with the desired software version! |                           |

| 6 | The DucoBox starts the update $ ightarrow$ during the update, the LED indication will flash purple.  |                           |

| 7 | Then press the INST button for a few seconds: all LED indications of the connected components will flash red (= reset of the existing network)   | INST OC<br>               |

| 9 | All components must be (re)paired with the network. Follow the standard instructions for this.   |                           |
